



DAY 1 - MALAYSIA - PARO - THIMPHU (1.5 HRS / 50 KM) (MOB/L/D)

- **** Rinpung Dzong:** Built in 1646, meaning "fortress full of treasures," it is a religious, administrative, and cultural center known for its Tibetan architecture and historical significance.
- **※ Kyichu Lhakhang:** One of Bhutan's oldest temples, built in the 7th century, offering a glimpse into rural Bhutanese life and the chance to try traditional rice wine, Ara.
- **** Tachogang Lhakhang Bridge:** A scenic iron chain bridge built by Drupthob Thangtong Gyalpo, leading to the famous Tachogang Lhakhang Dzong.

DAY 2 - THIMPHU FESTIVAL (B/L/D)

- **** Thimphu Festival (Tashichho Dzong):** Bhutan's most important festival, featuring religious ceremonies and traditional dances that highlight the country's culture & beliefs.
- **X Kuenselphodrang Nature Park (Buddha Point):** Home to the nation's largest Buddha statue, the 169-foot-tall seated Buddha Shakyamuni, with breathtaking views over the Thimphu valley.
- **** National Memorial Chorten:** Built in honor of Bhutan's third king, this stupa reflects the deep reverence of the Bhutanese for both their king and religion.
- **Motithang Takin Preserve:** A sanctuary for the gentle and rare takin, Bhutan's national animal, which roams freely in the forests.
- **X Jungshi Handmade Paper Factory:** A preservation project showcasing traditional handmade paper production using ancient techniques passed down through generations.
- **** Bhutan Post office Headquarters:** Bhutan is the world' famous "stamp-country" and you may create your own personalized stamp here, and send with those postcards to your beloved friends and family.
- **** Norzin Lam Street and Handicrafts Market:** A popular area for authentic Bhutanese handicrafts, clothing, and accessories, ideal for souvenir shopping.
- **** Simply Bhutan Museum:** A living museum dedicated to preserving Bhutanese traditional culture, where visitors can try archery, Bhutan's national sport.

DAY 3 - THIMPHU (3.5 HRS / 135 KM) GANGTEY (2 HRS / 75 KM) PUNANKHA (B/L/D)

- **** Gangtey Gonpa Monastery:** Bhutan's largest Nyingma monastery, a peaceful and historic site with strong religious significance.
- **** Phobjikha Valley:** A vast glacial valley with meandering streams and dense coniferous forests, known for its scenic beauty and as a wintering ground for the rare black-necked cranes.
- **** Black-Necked Crane Visitor Center:** An educational center offering insights into these rare cranes, making it a popular destination for nature enthusiasts and bird watchers.

DAY 4 - PUNAKHA - PARO (3 HRS / 105 KM) (B/L/D)

- **** Sopsokha Village Walk:** A small village where Lam Drukpa Kinley, the Divine Madman, is said to have subdued a demoness using a phallus to discipline evil spirits.
- **** Chimi Lhakhang:** A famous pilgrimage site known as the Temple of Fertility, particularly popular among childless couples seeking blessings.
- **X Punakha Dzong:** This iconic dzong lies at the confluence of the Mo Chhu and Pho Chhu rivers and is a prime spot for scenic photography and religious blessings.
- **X Punakha Suspension Bridge:** One of Bhutan's longest suspension bridges, spanning a scenic river, ideal for capturing memorable photos.
- **** Monk Blessing Ceremony:** A series of religious rites performed by monks and lamas, offering blessings for a happy and prosperous life.
- **** Dochula Pass:** A mountain pass with panoramic snow-capped views and 108 memorial chortens, built in honor of Bhutan's royal family.
- **** Druk Wangyal Chorten:** A set of stupas commissioned by the Royal Queen Mother in tribute to Bhutan's royal family, serene and beautifully constructed.

DAY 5 - PARO (B/L/D)

- **** Tiger's Nest:** Bhutan's iconic cliffside monastery, perched 900m above Paro Valley. Built in 1692, it is said Guru Rinpoche flew here on a tigress to meditate and subdue demons. Visitors can hike or ride halfway, then continue on foot.
- **X Drugyel Dzong:** The "Fortress of Victory," built by Zhabdrung Ngawang Namgyal in 1647 to commemorate his victory over the Mongol warlord Gushri Khan. A wonderful photo stop, rich with history.
- **** Bhutanese Traditional Dress Experience:** Try on Bhutan's traditional attire, the Gho and Kira, and capture the perfect cultural photo of the day.

DAY 6 - PARO - MALAYSIA (B/L/MOB)

※ Paro Town: A leisurely day for shopping in the town, where you can select unique Bhutanese handicrafts and souvenirs to take home, concluding your journey in Bhutan.

DAY 7 – ARRIVAL IN MALAYSIAYour Bhutan journey ends here, Tashi Delek!

第1天-马来西亚-帕罗-廷布(1.5小时/50公里)(机上用餐/午/晚餐)

- ※ **日蓬宗**: 建于1646年,意为"堆满珍宝的堡垒"。它是宗教、行政和文化的中心,以 其壮丽的藏式建筑和历史地位闻名。
- **※ 祈楚拉康:** 不丹最古老的寺院之一,建于7世纪,是农耕文化与宗教信仰的交汇地。品尝传统米酒Ara,体验不丹农民生活。
- **※ 塔秋冈拉康:** 一座由传奇铁索桥匠人Drupthob Thangtong Gyalpo建造的桥梁,连接塔秋冈拉康宗堡,风景优美。

第2天 - 廷布节(早/午/晚餐)

- **※ 廷布节(扎西确宗):** 不丹最重要的传统节庆之一,通常在不丹首都廷布的扎西确宗举行。节日期间,举办丰富的宗教仪式和传统舞蹈表演,展示不丹深厚的文化底蕴和宗教信仰。人们身着色彩鲜艳的传统服饰,参与盛大的庆典,舞蹈和仪式充满神圣与庄严。
- ※ Kuenselphodrang 自然公园(金剛座釋迦牟尼佛像): 拥有全国最大的169英尺高的 释迦牟尼佛像,俯瞰廷布山谷,景色壮丽。
- ※ 国家纪念佛塔: 为纪念第三代国王修建的佛塔,展现不丹对宗教和国王的崇敬之情
- ※ Motithang 羚羊保护区: 栖息着不丹国兽Takin,这种温顺的动物独特而有趣。
- ※ Jungshi 手工纸厂: 展示使用古法制作传统手工纸的过程,体现不丹传统工艺的魅力。
- **※ 国家邮政总局:**不丹是世界著名的"邮票之国",您可以在这里制作属于您自己的个性化邮票,并连同这些明信片一起寄给您心爱的亲朋好友。
- ※ Norzin Lam 街区与工艺品集市: 不丹手工艺品的天堂,提供精美的服饰和配饰选择。
- ※ "简单不丹"博物馆:一个活态文化博物馆,保护不丹的传统生活方式,体验射箭等特色活动。

第 3 天 - 廷布 (3.5 小时 / 135 公里) 岗提 (2 小时 / 75 公里) 普那卡 (早/午/晚餐)

- **※ 岗提贡巴寺**: 宁玛派的精神中心,周围被群山环抱,空气清新,充满浓厚的宗教氛围。这里不仅是朝圣者的圣地,也是游客体验不丹佛教文化与宗教历史的理想之地。
- ※ **富毕卡山谷**: 四周被茂密的森林覆盖,溪流在山谷间蜿蜒流淌。这个美丽的山谷是 黑颈鹤每年迁徙的重要栖息地,每到冬季,成群的黑颈鹤会飞来此地栖息。
- ※ 黑颈鹤游客中心: 一个为自然爱好者和鸟类研究者提供有关黑颈鹤及其栖息地的知识展示的地方。中心内展示了关于黑颈鹤的生态、迁徙路径以及保护工作的重要信息,还设有观察平台,方便游客观察这些珍稀的鸟类。

第4天-普那卡-帕罗(3小时/105公里)(早/午/晚餐)

- ※ 索索卡村徒步游: 位于稻田中的小村庄索索卡,据说是神圣的疯僧喇嘛竹巴吉列用阳具制服恶灵并加以驯服的地方。
- **※ 切米拉康寺:** 不丹著名的祈子寺庙,特别适合无子女的夫妻前来朝圣祈福,充满灵性的祝福地。
- **※ 普那卡宗:** 坐落于两河交汇处的不丹标志性宗堡,以其宏伟建筑和宗教祝福仪式闻名,是游客拍照和感受宗教氛围的热门之选。
- **※ 普那卡吊桥:** 不丹最长的吊桥,横跨清澈河流,两岸风景如画,是不可错过的徒步景点。
- **※ 僧侣祈福仪式:** 是由佛教僧侣和喇嘛举行的一系列宗教仪式。这些仪式体现了<mark>咒语</mark>的重要性,并将为您祈求幸福与繁荣的生活。
- ※ 多楚拉山口:雪山环绕的美丽山口,拥有108座纪念佛塔,庄严肃穆。
- **※ 楚克旺耶纪念碑:** 由皇太后为纪念不丹王室和国家而建的佛塔,建筑精美,气势恢宏,是不丹文化的象征之一。

第5天-帕罗(早/午/晚餐)

- ※ 虎穴寺: 不丹最具标志性的悬崖寺庙,位于帕罗谷上方900米的悬崖上。该寺庙建于1692年,传说 Guru Rinpoche(宗喀巴大师)曾骑着一只母虎飞到这里,在山洞中冥想并降伏恶魔。游客可以选择徒步登山或骑马至半山,然后继续步行至寺庙,途中风景如画,是不容错过的经典体验。
- ※ 卓杰宗: 胜利堡垒,纪念不丹战胜蒙古军阀的历史事件,是拍照留念的佳地。
- **※ 不丹传统服饰体验:** 游客可以穿上不丹传统服装——男性的"戈"和女性的"基拉", 亲身体验不丹的传统文化。你可以拍下身着传统服饰的照片,留下难忘的回忆,感受不丹的文化与魅力。

第6天-帕罗-马来西亚(早/午/机上用餐)

※ 帕罗小镇: 自由购物的不二之选,挑选独特的不丹手工艺品和纪念品,为旅行画上完美句号。
